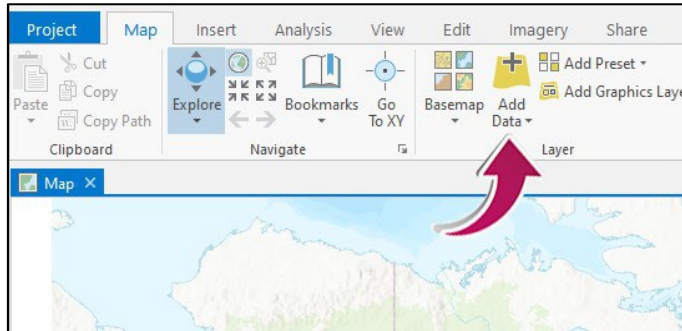
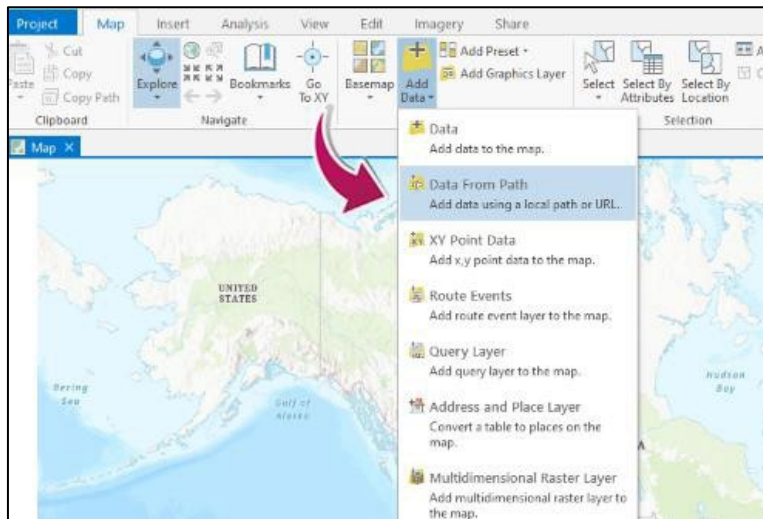


Using Image Service URLs in ArcPro

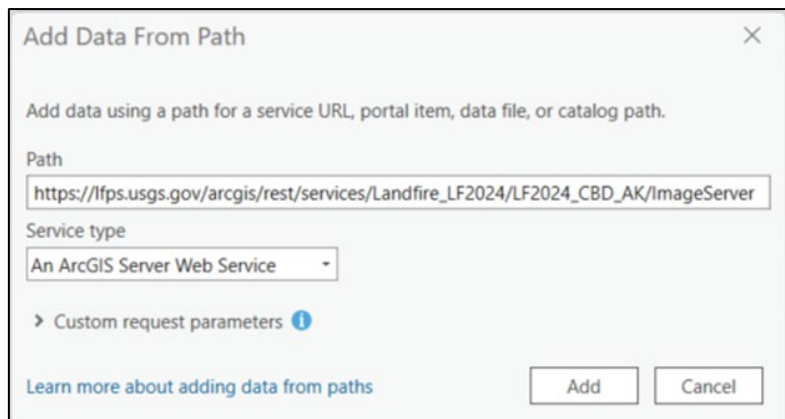
1. Select any LANDFIRE Image Service URL from the list at <https://lfps.usgs.gov/arcgis/rest/services>
2. Copy the URL for the layer you wish to use
3. Start ArcGIS Pro (ArcPro)
4. Start a “Map”
5. Click on **Add Data** (plus sign)



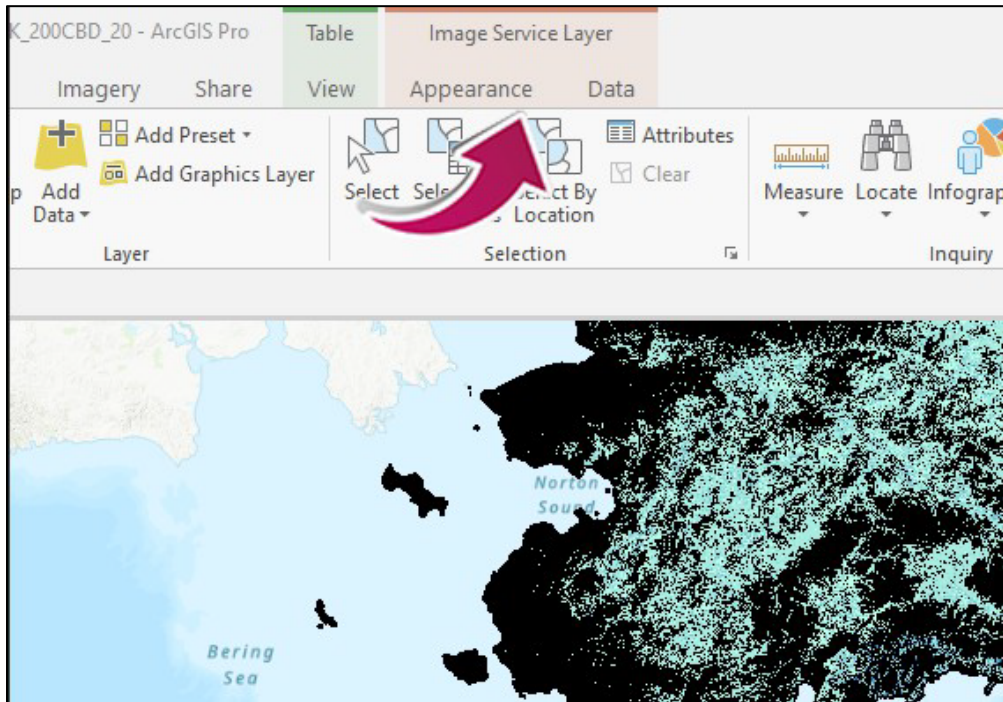
6. Select **Data From Path**



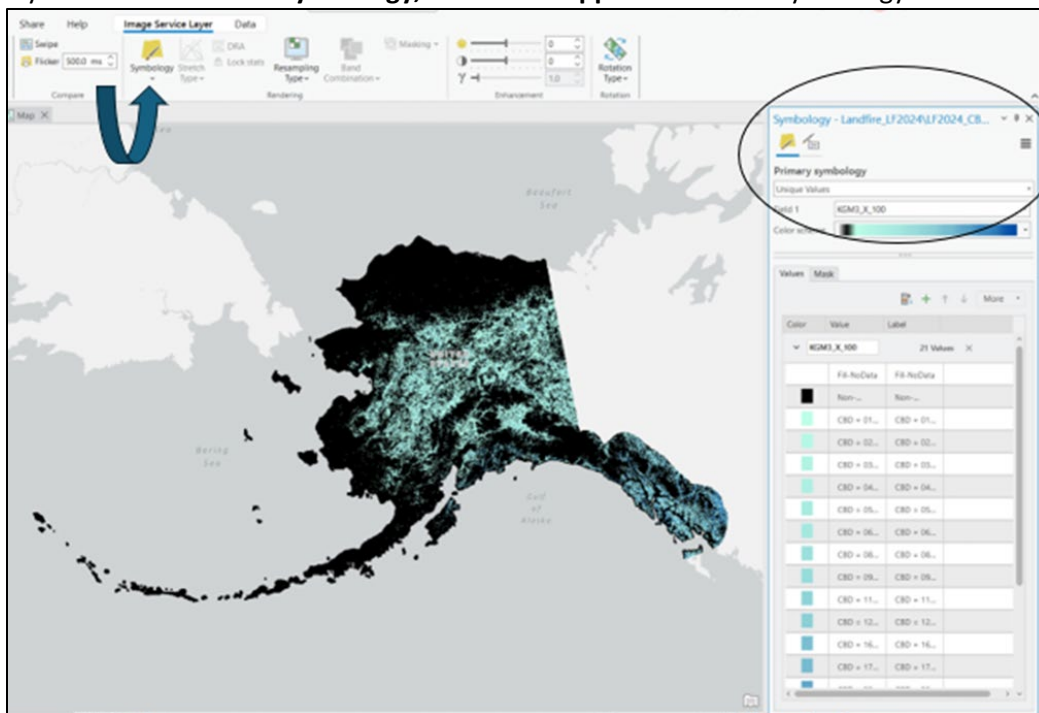
7. Copy the Image Service URL link from Step 1 into the “Path” text box



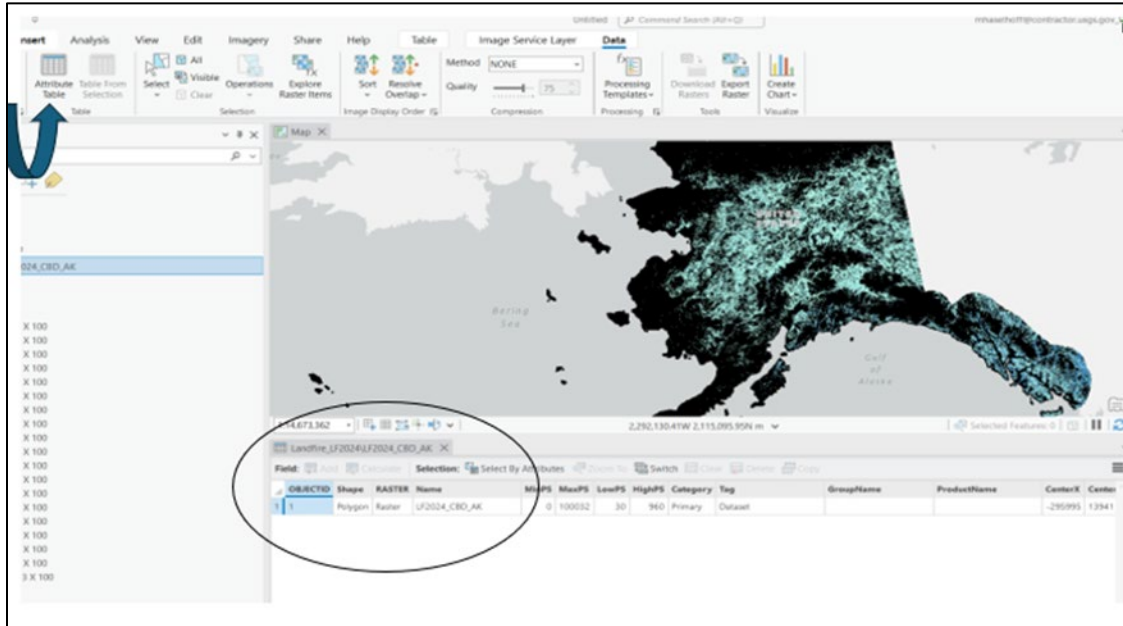
8. Click “Add”
9. There will now be an “Image Service Layer” tab in your ArcPro project.



10. If you want to view the **Symbology**, select the “Appearance” and Symbology icon.



11. If you want to view the attribute table, select the **Data** tab and then select the “Attribute Table” icon.



5. To “Identify” unique values per pixel, **click on the map**, and a pop-up screen will appear to show you the identifying information for that pixel.
